Registration

- Registration takes place the week or two before the start of fall classes. The first month's tuition is due at the time of registration.
- We reserve the right to cancel or combine any class due to lack of enrollment.
- All students have the opportunity to perform at the year end recital.

Tuition

- Private & semi private classes must be paid at the beginning of the month. A make-up class will only be given if a cancellation is made 24 hours prior to class time.
- A private/semi-private contract must be signed.

Tuition / Incidental Charges

- All tuition is due and payable by the 1st of the month.
- Payments received after the 1st will automatically be assessed a \$10 late fee/month on balances under \$100 and a \$15 late fee/month on balances over \$100.
- Students will be suspended from class if tuition is not paid for the month.
- Discounts will be offered for multiple classes
- A 5% discount will be offered for full payment for the year (Paid in September)
- A 5% discount will be given to siblings. Full tuition will be applied to the higher tuition rate.
- There will be a \$25 charge for all returned checks.
- Incidental charges must be paid at the time of the order.-We require a month's written notice of intention of withdrawal from class. You will be responsible for the month's tuition.
- NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON

Make-up Classes

- Make-up classes are available if there is a parallel class and the studio is notified.
- We do not give refunds or credit for absences
- A student must not miss more than 10 classes if he/she wishes to participate in the recital

Studio Closing

- **Holidays**- Labor Day -Saturday-Monday; Thanksgiving-Thursday-Sunday; Christmas-Christmas Eve through New Year's Day; Easter-Good Friday - Easter Sunday; Memorial Day - Saturday-Monday; Fourth of July.

Recital and Costumes

- There will be an admittance charge for the recital
- Recital Fee: Due to increased costs a recital fee is in place. You have a choice of either paying the fee or selling ads. Two admission tickets are given with this fee.

FEE- \$35/per student or \$55/per family

OR

ADS- Sell \$50per student or \$100per family

- All students will be measured in October for the mid-June recital
- A costume deposit is due per child/ costume at registration.
- Costume balances are due by December 15th. Costumes will not be ordered until full payment is made
- There is a \$10 late fee per costume after December 15th.
- Orders placed after December 15th will not be guaranteed delivery by class pictures or recital.
- \$15 service fee for costume exchanges
- No refunds for any reason unless notice is given by Oct. 30th.
- A student may not miss more than 10 classes to participate in the recital

Dance Attire

- Ballet and any combination with Ballet- Black leotard, pink tights, hair in bun.
- Ballet Levels III and up- Capezio tank or camisole black leotard, ballet belt
- Any other class- Any color leotard, tights, hair must be pulled back

Shoes

- Jazz- Please see teacher
- Hip Hop- Please see teacher
- Tumbling, modern & belly dancing- No shoes
- Tap- Black tap shoes with button -(Level III & IV- Please see teacher)
- Ballet- Pink ballet shoes(No Wal Mart or Payless shoes) Levels III & up split-sole shoes
- Lyrical- Tan half soles or toe thongs

Studio Code of Ethics

- No smoking in or around the studio
- No gum chewing in the studio area
- No food or drink allowed in dance rooms
- Good conduct is expected from all students, parents and guests in the dance room as well as the waiting room
- Any student, parent or guest who is constantly disruptive will be asked to leave.
- As this is a professional business, parents are responsible for the care and control of children in the waiting room and in the building.
